Show entries will be accepted the day of the show @\$10 per class entry fee and \$10 per horse office fee.

Jackpot Payouts are as follows:

(25% of jackpot entries will be retained by NTSF)

1-3 entries 1st – 100%
 4-6 entries 1st – 65%; 2nd – 35%
 7-9 entries 1st – 60%; 2nd – 30%; 3rd 10%
 10 or more 1st – 50%; 2nd – 25%; 3rd – 17%; 4th – 8

All horses must present negative Coggins when they check in! No exceptions!

The judge's decisions are final. Any exhibitor, or his representative, that interferes with, or displays disrespect to the show judge or show management, is subject to disqualification and will be asked to leave the show grounds.

AQHA rules will be used with show management reserving the right to modify them as needed.

No exhibitor or parent will be allowed to talk with the judge until AFTER the show is complete. Please contact show management with questions or clarification during the show.

All protests must be made in writing, accompanied with a non-refundable \$100 fee and plainly state the cause of the complaint.

Halter classes will not count for high point (except in the case of a tie).

Exhibitors must use a one-horse/one-rider combination for high point.

Ties for high point will be broken by halter placings, if necessary. If a tie still exists, the rider with the most first place finishes will be declared the winner. The judge will pre-identify a tie-breaker class that will be used, if necessary.

Points will be determined by the exhibitors in each class (i.e. 6 more or more in the class means 1st = 6 pts, 2nd = 5 pts, 3rd = 4 pts, 4th = 3 pts, 5th = 2 pts, 6th = 1 pt.) If there are less than six exhibitors in the class, the points are pro-rated (i.e. 4 exhibitors in the class means 1st = 4 pts, 2nd = 3 pts, etc.)

High point division must be declared at the time of entry and may not be changed once you exhibit in that particular division.

Safety: Boots are mandatory for all classes. Helmets are required for the English classes. Stallions are allowed only for 19 and over exhibitors. Any entry that is deemed unsafe to the horse, rider, spectators or other exhibitors will be excused from the class without discussion at the discretion of the judge and/or show superintendent.

Show Equipment and Attire: Show attire and equipment are optional, but the judge will consider legal equipment and appropriate attire in the overall presentation.

NO CROSS-ENTERING WALK/TROT CLASSES (NO EXCEPTIONS) – THESE CLASSES ARE PROVIDED FOR THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO ARE NOT READY FOR THE LOPE/CANTER CLASS.

In the event of rain, this event will be rescheduled for Sunday, August 16th at the same facility. Call (940) 367-4269 or (940) 453-7697 on the morning of the show if the weather looks questionable.

If we are able to make a decision about postponing the show, exhibitors will be notified via telephone or email.
