Entry fees: \$30 per head per Ring Deadline: August 20, 2025 @ 11:59 pm
 Late entries day of - August 21, 2025 @ 10:00 am with \$10 late fee per head.

 Online entries preferred and are available through the Showman app.

- Mail-in entries accepted through August 5, 2025
  No limit on the number of head an exhibitor may enter.
- Substitutions may be made upon arrival.
- 2. Exhibitors check in at livestock office. Packets will be received at this time with passes, weight cards & parking stickers. Weight cards must be turned into the livestock office by 11:00 am. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and no refund of fees.
- 3. Digital scales will be set up for use before weight cards are due.
- 4. Commercial LAMBS will be toothed and weighed.
- 5. Animals will be divided into classes as equally as possible. The show officials will determine the number of classes based on the total number of entries and weights .
- 6. Shavings will be available for purchase if needed
- 7. No minimum or maximum weight limit.
- 8. This is not a terminal show.
- 9. Show will consist of the following Breeds:
  - Southdown
  - Fine wool
  - Fine wool cross
  - Medium Wool
  - Haired Sheep
- 10. Animals do not require a certificate from breed registry.
- 11. Ring A ribbons
  - Ring B Class, Breed & Reserve Breed, Grand & Reserve Grand Champions awards
- 12. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place lambs and random lambs will be subject to be weighed back. Any lamb weighing more than 5 lbs below or above their weigh-in weight will be disqualified.
- 13. Note: No lambs allowed in barn until 7:00 pm Thursday.
