- 6. Not a terminal show
- 7. Show order: American Breeds, British Breeds, Exotic Breeds
- 8. Blow & Show No adhesives, glue, dyes or paint.
- 9. No outside bedding allowed, Shavings and pellets will be available for purchase on grounds
- 10. Show order: American Breeds, British Breeds, Exotic Breeds
- 11. Official classifier(s) for Junior Steer show will review any questionable animals pertaining to the class or breed before entering the show arena. If sifted, the steer may show in one of the crossbred classes determined by the official classifier(s).
- 12. All cattle for exhibition must be shown with a halter and be sufficiently gentle to be properly handled by exhibitor or attendant
