 - Friday, August 22, 2025 – 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Arrival continues
 - Paper check in office by 11:00 a.m.
 - Release: Following completion of breed if not in champion drive.
 - Trailer parking ONSITE, pending weather. Overflow trailer parking offsite.
 - NO SHOWING OFF TRAILER. Livestock must be stalled in barn.
 - Health certificates NOT required for TEXAS LIVESTOCK ONLY.
 - State validation NOT required.
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SPECIAL RULES

1. Entry fees: \$30 per head per ring Deadline: August 21, 2025 @ 11:59 pm
Late entries day of - August 22, 2025 @ 10:00 am with \$10 late fee per head.
Online entries **preferred** and are available through the Showman app.
Mail-in entries accepted through August 5, 2025
 - No limit on the number of head an exhibitor may enter.
 - Substitutions may be made upon arrival.
2. Exhibitors check in at livestock office. Packets will be received at this time with passes, weight cards & parking stickers.
3. Breeding sheep must be registered in the recognized flock books of their respective breeds prior to August 1, 2025 and bear such identification as that breed association requires.
4. Original registration certificates are required.
5. Breeding ages: For the purpose of this show, the following will apply regarding ages of breeding sheep.
 - Lambs must be carrying all milk teeth. Lambs showing either or both of their first pair of permanent incisors.
 - Sheep eligible to compete in the two-tooth breeding classes must show only the first pair of permanent incisors. Sheep which have dropped their central pair of milk teeth and show one or both teeth of the first permanent pair may show as singles only in the two-tooth classes of their respective breeds.
 - Sheep showing the first two to three pairs of permanent incisors may show as singles in the four to six tooth class only.
 - Sheep with more than six permanent teeth may not exhibit in the show.
