Contestants will be asked to introduce themselves during the pageant. Be prepared to state your parents' or guardians' names, what school you attend and your future ambitions. This will be the personality portion of your competition.

Contestants will be judged in formal wear (after 5 or prom dress).

Orientation is mandatory for each contestant. We will be discussing the events of the evening, so please arrive at DATCU Fair Hall at your designated time and date.

Contestants will receive their number during orientation. Numbers should be pinned on the right side at fingertip level.
