## **RULES & GUIDELINES**

Media professionals seeking permission to cover any aspect of the North Texas Fair & Rodeo must submit an application to Marketing & Media Manager Hannah Crandall (hannah@ntfair.com) between July 15, 2024 and August 9, 2024. Without submitting an application, there is no guarantee we will be able to accommodate your request in the timeframe you are seeking. Applicants may be asked to explain current media efforts or show past coverage of the North Texas Fair & Rodeo prior to being considered for media credentials.

In obtaining media credentials, the credential holder agrees to provide any content or material gathered or created during the event to the North Texas Fair & Rodeo to use throughout the year and years to come, as desired, for marketing purposes. All credentialed media agree to promptly cease use of such media materials or content at North Texas Fair & Rodeo's request.

To request interviews, media is asked to contact Marketing & Media Manager Hannah Crandall (<a href="https://nanah@ntfair.com">https://nanah@ntfair.com</a>) at least 48 hours in advance.

Media outlets may only use 30-seconds of concert footage for any coverage. Note: Concert coverage is dependent on individual artist approval.

The North Texas Fair & Rodeo may modify this policy at any time and for any reason. Each credential holder shall abide by this policy and any subsequent modifications as issued by the North Texas Fair & Rodeo. Misuse of media credentials to gain or attempt to gain access to prohibited areas or to conduct or attempt to conduct unauthorized interviews may result in immediate revocation of credentials, removal from the facilities and loss of future media privileges.

The North Texas Fair & Rodeo reserves the right to deny or revoke credentials for any media professional for any reason. Each media professional will be assigned a media credential to be worn at all times when on the grounds, which will also come with access to the North Texas Fair & Rodeo for a set number of days agreed upon by the North Texas Fair & Rodeo.

Credentialed media will NOT be allowed in the rodeo arena, in the show ring or at the livestock show backdrop, unless otherwise specified by the North Texas Fair & Rodeo. All media must shoot from the stands/outside the fence in these areas.

Media credentials do NOT grant permission to conduct interviews without a North Texas Fair & Rodeo official (Marketing & Media Manager Hannah Crandall or Executive Director Glenn Carlton) present.

All marks, logos and depictions of events, exhibits, competitions, concerts and presentations associated with any part of the North Texas Fair & Rodeo are the intellectual property of the North Texas Fair & Rodeo.

North Texas Fair & Rodeo logos are available for media use and may be requested from Marketing & Media Manager Hannah Crandall (hannah@ntfair.com). Each logo must be used in the form provided, as high quality and not mutilated, distorted or combined with any third-party logos, unless otherwise specified by the North Texas Fair & Rodeo. If the North Texas Fair & Rodeo objects to use of its logos, such use must immediately be removed or corrected to the North Texas Fair & Rodeo's satisfaction.

Media credentials will only be released to the specified and approved media professional, or another representative from that particular outlet. Representatives may be asked to show proof of work, identification, etc. Each media credential must be signed for by the credential holder or the approved representative picking up the credential. Media credentials and their associated tickets may be picked up between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. from July 15, 2024 through August 9, 2024 upon approval.




