- Arrival & Check – In: Thursday, August 21, 2025 – 4:00 pm– 9:00 pm
  - Friday, August 22, 2025 – 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. Arrival continues.
  - Release: Following completion of breed if not in champion drive.
  - Trailer parking ONSITE, pending weather. Overflow trailer parking offsite.
  - NO SHOWING OFF TRAILER. Livestock must be stalled in the barn.
    - Health certificates NOT required for TEXAS LIVESTOCK ONLY.
    - State validation is NOT required.

## SPECIAL RULES

1. Entry fees: \$30 per head                      Deadline: August 20, 2025 @ 11:59 pm  
Late entries day of - August 21, 2025 @ 8:00 am with \$10 late fee per head.  
Online entries ***preferred*** and are available through the Showman app.  
Mail-in entries accepted through August 5, 2025
  - No limit on the number of head an exhibitor may enter.
  - Substitutions may be made upon arrival.
2. Exhibitors check in at livestock office. Packets will be received at this time with passes, weight cards & parking stickers. Weight cards must be turned into the livestock office by 8:00 am. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and no refund of fees.
3. Digital scales will be set up for use before weight cards are due.
4. Commercial LAMBS will be toothed and weighed.
5. Animals will be divided into classes as equally as possible. The show officials will determine the number of classes based on the total number of entries and weights .
6. No outside bedding allowed, Shavings and pellets will be available for purchase on grounds.
7. No minimum or maximum weight limit.
8. This is not a terminal show.
9. Show will consist of the following Breeds:
  - Finewool
  - Southdown
  - Dorper
  - Medium Wool
10. Animals do not require a certificate from breed registry.
11. Ribbons for class placings. Awards for Breed & Reserve Breed, Overall Champions.
